The plan to relocate the garden after the show next to the bottom playground has fuelled a very exciting phase 2 project. We have had the most generous offer from one of our inspirational parents who has her own business Evans Excavation #diglikeagirl. Mrs Evans has offered to landscape the current area which is at present unusable as a space and further to that, extend the area into the woodland alongside the garden to provide a further 'woodland walk' wellbeing space. The digging and excavation process will be undertaken during the school day in the near future to enable the children to see this incredible role model at work. Once the area has been levelled and cleared by Mrs Evans we will be looking to install seating, wooden sleeper planters and block fencing.
