This week the children participated in the Speak Out. Stay Safe programme. The programme was delivered by the NSPCC. Speak Out. Stay Safe is a safeguarding programme for children aged 5 to 11 years old (Years 1 – 6). It helps children understand:

- Abuse in all its forms and how to recognise the signs of abuse.
- That abuse is never a child's fault and they have the right to be safe.
- Where to get help and the sources of help available to them, including the <u>Childline</u> service.


