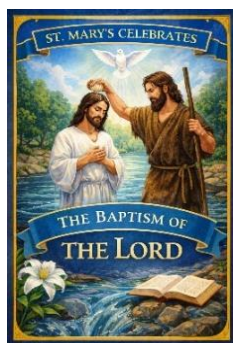

On Monday, the SANCTA Squad led our whole-school Celebration of the Word, focusing on Baptism. The children reflected on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and the importance of water, sharing the story of Mortikana from southern Ethiopia. They learned how her life changed when CAFOD built a water tank for her village, removing the need for long daily walks to collect water. This provided a meaningful opportunity to reflect on the CST principle of Stewardship and how we can use water more thoughtfully and avoid waste.

PUPIL PREMIUM / FREE SCHOOL MEALS



Some families are eligible for additional funding through the UK Government's Free School Meals initiative. NHS PHARMACY FIRST

The [NHS Pharmacy First Service](#) enables children and adults to get convenient access to healthcare advice and treatment where appropriate, for seven common conditions without the potential delay of having to wait for a GP appointment. Accessing the service may mean that children feel better and are back to school as quickly as possible, as well as supporting parents/carers to also get better if they are unwell with one of the conditions covered under the service.

There is no need to make an appointment; parents or carers can pop into [Boots pharmacy](#) in Marple with their child and ask for help under the service.



STAFFING UPDATE

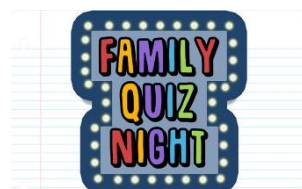
